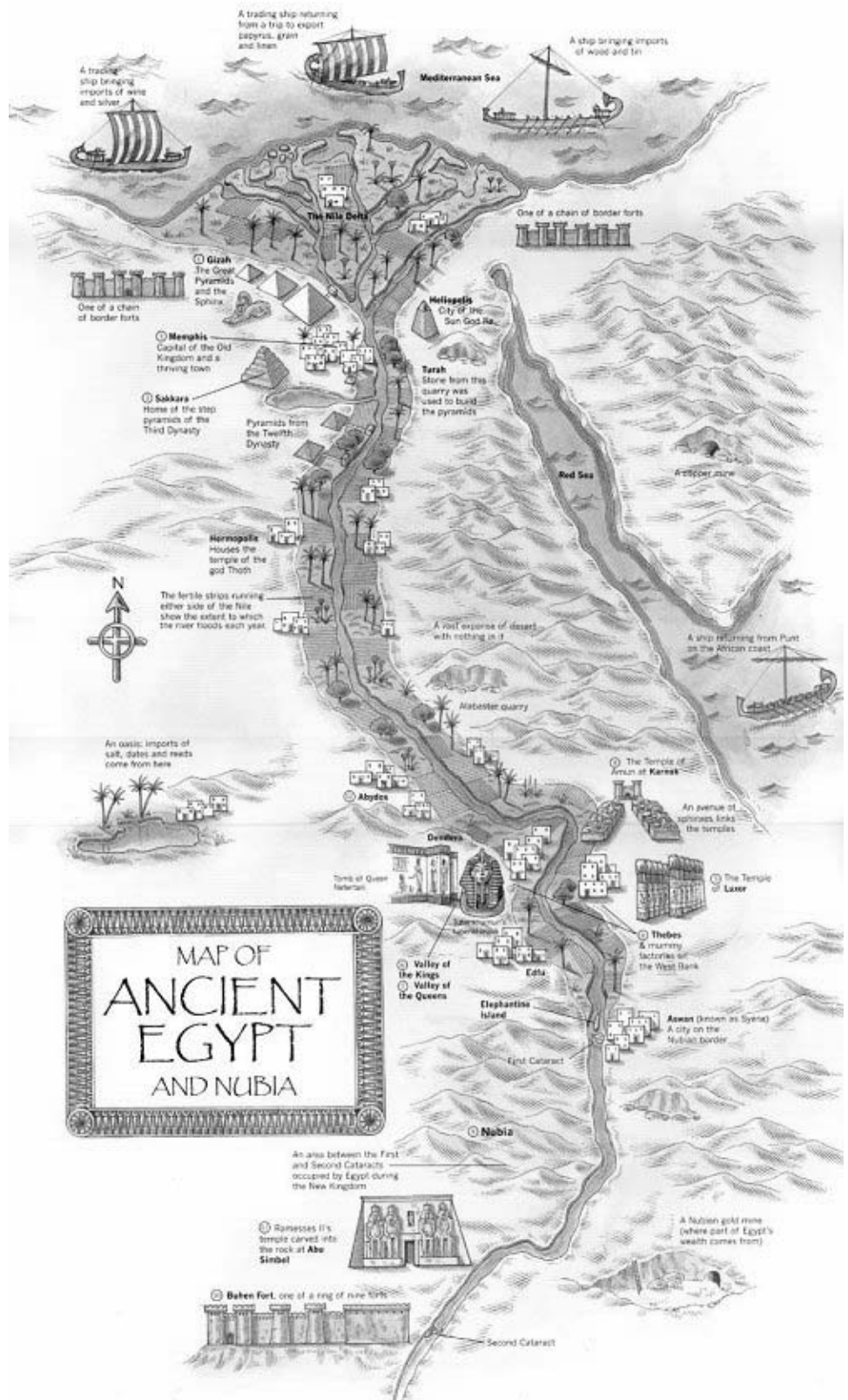
Egypt: Gift of the Nile

- ◆ Cropland raised in the fertile land along the river
- ◆ Irrigation canals that spread Nile water over the dry land
- ◆ Papyrus used for making paper.
- ◆ Reeds used for reed matting.
- ◆ Fish eaten and sold for food.
- ◆ Waterfowl, hunted and often eaten.
- ◆ Water for bathing.
- ◆ Boating for recreation and hunting.
- ◆ Ships traveling easily to transport goods and promote trade.
