Hideaway in History!

BASIC IDEA: Gladiator Arena in the Colosseum

For this project, there isn't an idea in *Creating Clever Castles and Cars*, but it's easy to create this hideaway. See page 190 of "Usborne Encyclopedia of World History" to get some idea of a basic outline for your arena in the Colosseum. Your student can re-create the Colosseum and hold gladiator battles inside. Cut open two boxes so that they are flat strips, and create one big circle by connecting the two ends. You can cut out an arched entry in the middle of one of the strips.

ADD MORE DETAIL: Student can draw the detail of the outside of the Colosseum as shown on page 190. Inside the Colosseum, students can draw wild animals or other gladiators. Student can stage battles with small action figures, toy soldiers, etc. Stuffed animals can get in on the action, too!
