It's Your First Week!

Introduction to Explode the Code, 7 & 8

We are going to jump right in here! This year in the "Explode the Code" texts, you will be studying more phonograms and language skills.

Introduction to SpellWell

You have 30 lessons in the two SpellWell books. Each lesson has four activities to complete throughout the week. Each word list has 7-9 SpellWell words and 1-2 outlaw words, with room for a couple of individualized words that your student needs to know or has trouble with. **(You do not need to complete the introductory page for each lesson and you do not NEED to add words to the list.)** The test for each lesson is scheduled on the fifth day, but this could be changed to accommodate a four-day schedule.

Creative Composition

Most weeks of the year there is an assignment, except for Animal Worlds' student, who will do their "Notebook."

Language Arts Activities

Each 5th day, an activity from "Language Arts Activities" will be scheduled. If you want to stick to a four-day schedule, complete it on one of the other days.

Handwriting Pages

Handwriting is not scheduled for every day, but space is provided for you to check it off when you complete it. There is one suggestion listed per week with details on how to complete it. There are reproducible sheets to use for handwriting practice included in this program. You will need to write out an example for the student to follow in some cases.

What to do for additional handwriting practice? Look for a comprehensive list of ideas in the introductory notes of this program guide. These are used throughout the year, but could be done more than once. Again, do not feel you must practice handwriting every day. There is a lot of handwriting required in the other workbooks.
