Catacombs Night

Prepare a simple supper that you could share with believers in the catacombs. Turn your living room into a rocky cave. Use sheets to create rock walls or ledges. Make a simple meals such as fresh fruit with bread. Light the room with candles or small lamps -- with parental supervision. Invite friends to share the meal. Try singing a few songs.
